Peter's expertise in mine planning, technical evaluations, due diligence reviews and feasibility studies developed whilst working for major resource companies at operating mines in Broken Hill, in the corporate environment in Melbourne and in an in-house consulting role based in Perth. His exposure covers a wide range of mining methods, mine planning, capital projects and underground materials handling systems and infrastructure.

SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

Peter began his career in 1977 as a trainee mining engineer at New Broken Hill Consolidated Limited in Broken Hill, studying part time at the Broken Hill campus of the University of New South Wales. He graduated with a BEng Mining (Hons) in 1983.

After graduating, Peter worked in several roles ranging from underground supervisor, project engineer, ventilation engineer to mine planning. In 1988 he joined North Broken Hill Limited (North-Peko) as Senior Mining Engineer - Planning. With the formation of Pasminco later that year, he assumed responsibility for mine planning, scheduling, rock mechanics and survey departments for both the North Mine and ZC Mines operations in Broken Hill.

In 1995, Peter transferred to Pasminco's group office in Melbourne as Manager - Mining Support, working on evaluations and studies for the mining division. Peter left Pasminco in 1998 and joined North Limited as Principal Mining Engineer with the Technical Services Group based in Perth. In this role he worked predominantly on the feasibility study evaluating the development of the underground resource at Kanowna Belle Gold Mine, completing a detailed assessment on underground diesel truck haulage both from first principles and with the aid of computer simulation.

Since joining AMC in August 1999 Peter has been involved with the management, mining input, and independent peer review aspects of various underground mine feasibility and engineering studies for projects in Australia, Indonesia and Africa. He has also carried out strategic planning, reviews, first principle cost modelling and auditing/reviewing of underground ore reserve estimates and methodology for a number of operations.

Peter has also conducted technical reviews and due diligence on projects in Australia, Turkey and Kyrgyz Republic for banks including Macquarie, Rothschilds, CBA and ANZ, as well as mining input for, and preparation of, various public reports and valuations.
