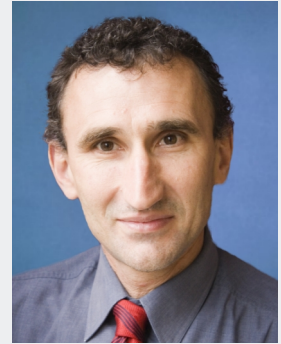

SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

Previous to that Frank worked for Sons of Gwalia Ltd, as Senior Mining Engineer, working for their Perth based Technical Services team.
