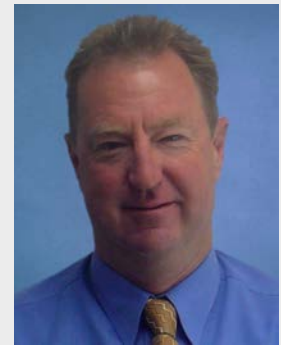

Bruce's primary expertise is in open pit mine planning and management, equipment selection, valuations, project management and cost estimation. His broad experience within the mining industry includes feasibility studies and mining software.

SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

Bruce commenced his mining engineering career in 1981 working at the Zinc Corporation in Broken Hill. He transferred to Bougainville Copper Ltd in 1985 and worked there in various mine planning positions including Production Control Superintendent and Project Mining Engineer. As Project Mining Engineer he was part of a team that evaluated earthmoving equipment options including in-pit crushing and conveying that was recommended and adopted by Bougainville Copper Ltd until 1989 when the mine closed.

Bruce then took up a position with Hamersley Iron. Initially he was employed as Superintendent Grade Control and Scheduling. After six months he was promoted to Principal Mining Engineer at Paraburdoo where his responsibilities included management of pit design, medium to long term production scheduling, geology and geotechnical work. After two years he was transferred to Tom Price as Principal Mining Engineer and during his two years there was seconded to the position of Manager Mine Production.

Bruce worked for eighteen months with a mining software company before taking a position as technical director of a junior public listed mining company.

In late 1996, Bruce commenced employment with AMC. Since then he has focused on open pit feasibility studies, equipment selection, open pit cost estimation and valuation projects.

During this period he has managed open pit feasibility studies and conducted numerous evaluations of open pits based on detailed cost estimation and production modelling. Several of these evaluations were in relation to contractor versus owner-mining decisions for large open pit operations. Bruce has extensive consulting experience within Australia and internationally. Some of the operations Bruce has consulted to include Mount Keith, Century Zinc, KCGM, Telfer, Pilbara Iron, Jack Hills Iron Ore, Alumbra, Tarmoola, St Ives, Cadia, Damang, Tarkwa, Chirano, Bozshakol, Aktogay and Murrin Murrin.

Bruce was seconded to Mount Keith Operations in 2003 for five months as Technical Services Manager.

Bruce was promoted to Manager, Open Pit Mining, in 2007 and then to General Manager, Perth in 2011.
