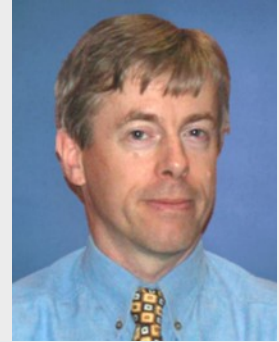

EXPERTISE

David's expertise is in the design and operation of open pit and underground mines. He has broad experience in gold and base metal operations having held management and planning roles in open pit and underground mines around Australia and Africa.

SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

David began his career in 1988 as a mining engineer at Pasminco Limited's Rosebery Mine (base metals using open stoping and cut and fill) in Tasmania, with time as an underground miner and mining engineer, with duties covering development, stope design, drill and blast and short term scheduling for a variety of mining methods.

In 1991, David moved to Western Australia to work at Normandy Mining Limited's Scuddles Mine (base metals using open stoping) as a mining engineer incorporating mine planning, drill and blast, mine production and ventilation roles. Further experience was gained as an underground supervisor and as project engineer at the start of the Gossan Hill decline.

In 1995 David joined Herald Resources as Senior Mining Engineer Open Pit at their Coolgardie Operations, gaining experience in open pit optimisation, design and scheduling. The Three Mile Hill pit was the first mine in Australia to use an 'in the wall' tunnel.

In 1997, following a period of travel, David joined Resolute Limited, where he spent the next 5½ years in a range of roles. These included two years as Quarry/Underground Manager at Higginsville in WA, six months in head office, one year as Chief Mining Engineer at Golden Pride (open pit) in Tanzania and two years as Mining Manager at Obotan (open pit) in Ghana. David left Resolute at the completion of mining at Obotan in late 2002.

David joined AMC in 2003 and primarily worked on underground mining studies for projects in Australia and Africa. He has also conducted open pit studies and technical reviews.

David left AMC in late 2006 to join Gold Fields Limited, as Principal Mining Engineer, providing technical support and project evaluation for Gold Fields International operations in Australia, Ghana, Venezuela and Peru.

David rejoined AMC in March 2008 as Underground Manager. Since then David has been involved with the management, mining inputs and peer review aspects of a number of open pit and underground projects, predominantly in Australia and Africa. He has also carried out reviews of ore reserve estimates and input into public reports and valuations.
