Peter has almost 30 years experience in the mining industry covering underground and open pit operations in Australian and international operations for numerous commodities. Peter's expertise is in underground and open pit mine planning and studies. During his time with AMC, Peter has undertaken and managed numerous mine studies from conceptual through to detailed feasibility studies. Peter has a well developed expertise in contemporary mine planning techniques but can still remember the traditional approaches.

SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

Peter joined AMC in 1999 as a Senior Mining Engineer. He has since worked on numerous open pit and underground projects within Australia and internationally. His consulting duties have ranged from operations reviews, undertaking pre-feasibility and feasibility studies through to project management of substantial underground and open pit studies. Peter was promoted to Principal Mining Engineer in 2005.

Prior to AMC, Peter worked for Ashanti Goldfields in Ghana as the acting Mine Engineering Superintendent for the Southern Mines for the final year of his contract. Peter initially joined Ashanti Goldfields as the Senior Planning Engineer and then Projects Engineer. He achieved in developing the 7.9 Mt Sansu North project into an operating mine.

In 1995, Peter worked for Placer Pacific's new Osborne Mine in Queensland as the Mine Planning Engineer. His role at Osborne Mine was to produce development and stope plans, schedules, budgets, tender documentation inputs and daily supervision of contractors for two blind bored shafts, underground development and open pit mining. Peter transferred to Osborne Mine from Placer Pacific's Porgera mine in PNG where he worked as a Production Engineer from 1993.

Peter's first association with AMC commenced in 1990 with James Askew Associates Pty Ltd as a Senior Mining Engineer providing consulting assistance to numerous underground and open pit mines in Australia.

From 1987 to 1990, Peter worked firstly with Costain's Minerals Division in Sydney as their Projects Engineer and then at Costain's Ravensworth Colliery in the Hunter Valley as the Mine Planning Engineer responsible for long term planning of their drag line operations.

Peter commenced his career as a labourer and miner with WMC at Kambalda and Norseman. He worked in supervisory roles at the various shafts, declines and pits to gain his Mine Manager's certification and then became a junior Mining Engineer working on various mine projects. His main achievement during this period was to develop the Okay Decline Mine from a conceptual stage through to the commencement of development.
