Damian has over 25 years experience in the mining industry and includes broad operational and technical roles in management, maintenance, engineering, procurement and logistics.

His focus in recent years has been on mining equipment asset management, selection and procurement and cost estimations for large open cut mining operations.

SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

Damian began his career as an electrical engineer with Hamersley Iron in 1981 at the Dampier Operations. In 1982 he was transferred to the Paraburdoo Operations and worked there in various engineering, maintenance and management roles including Supply Manager and Process Plant Manager.

Damian was transferred to the Dampier-based Product Quality Management Team in 1993, where, as Principal Advisor, he focused on crushing and screening research and the installation of prototype on-stream analysis equipment, including the measurement of moisture, alumina and primary crushed ore sizing.

In 1997 Damian accepted the role of Mining Equipment Maintenance Manager based at Tom Price. This role was later expanded in 1998 to include the maintenance management of the mining fleets at Paraburdoo, Marandoo and Brockman.

Damian worked for three years with Metplant Engineering based in Perth, where he managed various mining equipment projects, including a maintenance management secondment to the Leinster Operation in 2001 and the management of the haul truck procurement project for Hamersley Iron.

In mid-2004, Damian commenced with Pilbara Iron as Manager Fleet Planning and Procurement. This role was established to manage the planning and procurement of mobile equipment for Rio Tinto's Pilbara Iron Ore operations' significant expansion. In 2007 Damian moved into the role of Principal Advisor - Fleet Strategy and Application Engineering to develop long term heavy mining equipment strategies.

Damian joined AMC in March 2008 as a Principal Engineer, and has since worked on due diligence assignments, mining fleet analysis, selection and cost estimation projects and more recently a mining fleet procurement project for a client in Kazakhstan.
