Mehmet has more than 20 years underground mining experience gained in Australia, Europe and Africa. He has a wide range of operational and technical experience in underground metal and coal mines. Mehmet is a specialist in rock mechanics, mine backfill, technical studies, and management of mine technical services.

SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

Mehmet joined AMC in March 2005 and since then has been involved with many scoping and feasibility studies, mine design and planning, ore reserves estimates, geotechnical reviews and mine backfill studies, cost estimation and benchmarking. Mehmet acted as technical expert and lead engineer for various components of major feasibility studies including mining method assessment, mine design and planning, mine access options and haulage assessments, equipment selection and benchmarking.

Prior to joining AMC, Mehmet was Chief Mining Engineer at Inmet's Çayeli mine for 6.5 years where he was responsible for the management of the mine technical services team of 12 engineers and 2 technicians. Mehmet provided technical expertise to optimise mining in a very challenging mining environment, reviewed and approved short and long term mine designs, prepared life of mine plans and ore reserve statements, initiated and managed internal projects and continued business improvement initiatives, recommended, justified and submitted capital projects, controlled and monitored capital expenditures, negotiated and monitored mine rehabilitation contracts, mentored and developed subordinates, developed and prepared mine standards and acted in the roles of Mine Manager and Technical Services Manager.

Mehmet graduated as a Mining Engineer from Turkey's prestigious METU University with distinction and worked in Turkey during 1991 and 1992. Mehmet went to South Africa and spent 7 years working in various roles and he got his MSC degree in Rock Mechanics from the Wits University. Mehmet worked for Gold Fields of South Africa where he went through a 12 month development and production training. He gained hands on practical experience in mine ventilation, mine backfill and rock mechanics. After working as a Rock Mechanics Engineer at Kloof and Libanon gold mines, Mehmet was later transferred to Gold Fields Coal Division where he was promoted to Senior Rock Mechanics. Mehmet holds Chamber of Mines Certificates in Rock Mechanics for metal and coal mines.
